PARENTING

ADOPTION

NSHA uses a rotating list of adoption agencies and we are able to connect you with an agency anywhere in the county. We can also answer any questions you may have, discuss the adoption plans available to you, and help you choose the best option that fits your situation.

NSHA's 24/7 Crisis Hotline staff can discuss this option in more detail and share the nearest Safe Haven locations to you. Please call or text 1-866-707-2229 to learn more. Your baby will either be placed through the Department of Child and Family Services with a foster-to-adopt family or directly with an adoptive family, depending on your state's law.
